

BYLAW #16:2018
of the TOWN OF IRRICANA
in the PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

Being a bylaw of the Town of Irricana, in the Province of Alberta, for the purpose of regulating Cannabis Consumption in the Town of Irricana.

WHEREAS the Government of Canada has decided to legalize the use, sale, possession and cultivation of marijuana (cannabis), the Town of Irricana wishes to regulate the consumption of marijuana in the Municipality.

- 1) Marijuana may not be consumed in public areas including all parks, sidewalks, campground, sports areas, playgrounds, cemetery, recreation center, and community hall.
- 2) The Town may decide to designate a smoking area during concerts, festivals, sporting events, and social gatherings. These areas will be designated by signage as depicted in Appendix A. Any consumption must be within a 5-meter radius of the sign.
- 3) The Town may designate a smoking area adjacent to the campground for guests, although the Town recognizes that smoking is permitted within campers or tents.
- 4) Retail sales of marijuana are limited to no earlier than 10 AM and no later than 9 PM Sunday through Thursday, and no later than 11pm Friday and Saturday.
- 5) The interior of a vehicle is not to be considered a public place even if the vehicle is parked on a public road if the doors and windows are closed.
- 6) The Town may temporarily designate any area of the Municipality a smoking area for marijuana consumption.

EFFECTIVE DATE

AND FURTHER THAT this Bylaw shall take effect on the date of third and final reading.


