

**MUNICIPALITY OF ROBLIN
BY-LAW NO. 18-23**

**BEING A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ROBLIN TO SET
APPLICABLE RATES FOR THE ROBLIN WASTE DISPOSAL SITE.**

WHEREAS Section 250 (2) of the *Municipal Act* states in part that a municipality may for municipal purposes do the following: “(c) acquire, establish, maintain and operate services, facilities and utilities”;

AND WHEREAS Section 252 (1) of the *Municipal Act* states in part that a municipality “may set terms and conditions in respect of users, including (a) setting the rates or amounts of deposits, fees and other charges, and charging and collecting them”;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Municipality of Roblin, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

TITLE

1. This by-law may be referred to as the “Tipping Fees By-law”.

DEFINITIONS

- 2.1 “Resident” – Any person, firm or corporation within the municipality.
- 2.2 “Non-Resident” – Any person, firm or corporation outside of the Municipality of Roblin.

RATES


- 3.1 THAT the following rates be set:


	<u>Resident</u>	<u>Non-Resident</u>
(a) Household Waste	No Charge	\$35/ <1/2 ton
(b) Yard Waste (including trees & shrubs)	No Charge	\$100/1/2 ton to 1 ton \$35 per haul \$100/1/2 ton to 1 ton
(c) Mattresses (any size)	\$40/each	\$50/each
(d) Contaminated Soil/Asbestos Material	By Agreement Only	Not Accepted
(e) Demolished Building, Building Materials & Asphalt Shingles	\$40/1/2 ton to 1 ton \$100/2 to 3 ton \$200/tandem to semi-trailer	\$100/1/2 ton to 1 ton \$300/2 2 to 3 ton \$400/tandem to semi-trailer
(f) Grain Dust	\$100/semi-trailer	Not Accepted
(g) Refrigerators, Freezers & Air Conditioners	\$40 without “EF” sticker \$20 with “EF” sticker	\$60 without “EF” sticker \$30 with “EF” sticker
(h) Animal Carcasses/Remains(over 50 lbs. & No Bovine)	\$40 each	Not Accepted
(i) Tires with rims – passenger vehicles	\$10 each*	\$20 each*
Tires with rims – semi trucks or larger	\$30 each*	\$50 each*
* fee is for removal of rims		
(j) E-Waste (computer incl. monitor, keyboard & tower)	\$20 each*	Not Accepted*
* No charge if taken to Roblin Recycling Depot		

- 3.2 THAT these rates take effect July 1, 2023.

- 3.3 THAT By-law No. 3-20 is hereby repealed.
