**BY-LAW NO. 04-2017**

**Sewer Rates in the LUD of La Broquerie**

**BEING A BY-LAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF LA BROQUERIE TO PROVIDE FOR SEWER RATES IN THE LUD OF LA BROQUERIE AND THE COLLECTION THEREOF**

**WHEREAS** the Rural Municipality of La Broquerie has undertaken a sewer rate study in the LUD of La Broquerie that indicates sewer rates require to be increased;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 232 (1) and (2) of the "Municipal Act", S.M. 1996, c. 58, provides in part as follows:

- 232(1) A council may pass by-laws for municipal purposes respecting the following matters:
  - (l) public utilities;
- 232(2) Without limiting the generality of subsection (1), a council may in a by-law passed under this Division....
  - (d) establish fees or other charges for services, activities or things provided or done by the municipality or for the use of property under the ownership, direction, management or control of the municipality;


**AND WHEREAS** it is deemed advisable to provide rates effective January 1, 2019 and thereafter to be paid by persons to whom sewer service are supplied by the Rural Municipality of La Broquerie in the LUD of La Broquerie and to provide for the collection thereof;

**NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF LA BROQUERIE IN SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED, HEREBY ENACTS A BY-LAW AS FOLLOWS:**

- 1) **THAT** connected customers in the LUD of La Broquerie shall pay for sewer services supplied to them at the rates and under the terms set out in Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this by-law. Connected customers shall be billed quarterly charges for sewer services as set forth in Schedule "A".
- 2) **THAT** no person shall wilfully or maliciously hinder or cause to hinder the Municipality or its' representative in the exercise of their duties in relation to the operation and maintenance of the sewer system.
- 3) **THAT** any person violating any provision of this by-law shall:
  - a) be guilty of an offence and, upon conviction, liable to a fine not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500.00) and costs for each violation;
  - b) be liable to the Rural Municipality of La Broquerie for any expense, loss or damage suffered by the Rural Municipality of La Broquerie as a result of the violation;
  - c) be liable for the repairs and costs of the repairs to the system as a result of the violation. If that person is in default of effecting the repairs, the Rural Municipality of La Broquerie may affect the repairs and charge the cost thereof to that person, or add the cost to property taxes and collect those property taxes in the same manner as other property taxes.
- 4) **THIS** by-law and rates effective January 1, 2019 and thereafter, shall come into force and be effective on, from and after both approval of the Public Utilities Board of Manitoba and receipt of third and final reading thereof.
- 5) **THAT** By-law No 17-2012 be repealed as of January 1, 2019, and upon final approval of this By-law by the Public Utilities Board of Manitoba.
