

MUNICIPALITY OF HILLSBURG-ROBLIN-SHELL RIVER

BY-LAW NO. 8-15

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF HILLSBURG-ROBLIN-SHELL RIVER TO AUTHORIZE THE LICENSING OF TRANSIENT TRADERS SELLING GOODS, WARES OR ARTICLES OF FOOD WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY.

WHEREAS Section 232(2) of *The Municipal Act* provides that a council may by by-law:

- (e) subject to the regulations, provide for a system of licences, permits or approvals, including any or all of the following:
 - (i) establishing fees, and terms for payment of fees, for inspections, licences, permits and approvals, including fees related to recovering the costs of regulation.
 - (ii) establishing fees for licences, permits and approvals that are higher for persons or businesses who do not reside or maintain a place of business in the municipality,
- (g) require persons who do not reside or have a place of business in the municipality to report to the municipal office before conducting business in the municipality;

AND WHEREAS Council of the Municipality of Hillsburg-Roblin-Shell River deems it necessary and expedient to pass such a by-law;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipality of Hillsburg-Roblin-Shell River, in open session assembled, enacts as follows:

1. "Resident" means a person living within the boundaries of the Municipality of Hillsburg-Roblin-Shell River.

"Other" means a person who does not qualify under the definition of Resident.
2. THAT no person, other than a producer of produce of the province as defined in Section 237 of *The Municipal Act*, who is a transient trader, hawker, peddler or other person who goes from place to place, or from door to door, by any means, bearing or drawing any goods, wares or merchandise for sale, shall transact business in the Municipality of Hillsburg-Roblin-Shell River without first obtaining a licence to do so from the clerk or other proper officer of the Municipality.
3. THAT, subject to Section 238 of *The Municipal Act*, an annual fee shall be paid to the Municipality of Hillsburg-Roblin-Shell River as outlined below:
 - (a) Residents who pay a fee in lieu of business taxes in the Municipality of Hillsburg-Roblin-Shell River shall not be required to pay an additional licence fee.
 - (b) Residents who do not pay a fee in lieu of business taxes in the Municipality of Hillsburg-Roblin-Shell River shall be required to pay a licence fee of \$55.00.
 - (c) Others shall pay a licence fee as follows:

1. Door to Door or Home Party Sales Persons	\$130.00
2. Construction Trades	\$130.00
3. Clothing, Food, Crafts, Paintings	\$130.00
4. Service Sales Persons, Incl. Auctions & Tree Service	\$130.00
5. Others Not Classified Above	\$130.00
4. THAT business licences granted under this by-law shall be in effect from January 1st to December 31st of the year of issuance. Licences will not be pro-rated.
5. THAT any person, firm or corporation who contravenes, or refuses, neglects, omits


or fails to obey or observe any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offense and is liable, on summary conviction, to a fine not exceeding Two Hundred and Sixty Dollars (\$260.00), or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one month or to both such a fine and such an imprisonment. Where the contravention, refusal, neglect, omission, or failure, continues for more than one day, the person is guilty of a separate offense for each day that it continues.

6. THAT any other by-laws inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
7. THAT this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the 1st day of January, 2015.
