

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF PIPESTONE

BY-LAW NO. 2014-19

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY
to create a reduced speed zone adjacent to the Reston
School.

WHEREAS Section 232(1) of The Municipal Act, L.M. 1996, c. 58 - Chap. M225, provides as follows:

Spheres of jurisdiction

232(1) A council may pass by-laws for municipal purposes respecting the following matters:

- (a) the safety, health, protection and well being of people, and the safety and protection of property;

WHEREAS Section 98.1 of The Highway Traffic Act and the Reduced-Speed School Zones Regulation No. 136/2013 authorize a council to pass by-laws establishing the reduced maximum permitted speed for vehicles being driven on a highway within a school zone within the geographic boundaries of a municipality; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Rural Municipality of Pipestone deems it advisable and in the best interests of the Municipality to establish school zones with a reduced maximum speed for vehicles.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of Pipestone in open Council assembled enacts as follows:

1. This By-Law may be called the "Reston Reduced-Speed School Zone By-Law".

Interpretation

2. For the purposes of this By-Law, "highway", "reduced-speed school zone", "school", "school property", "traffic control device" and "vehicle" shall have the same meanings as set out in the Highway Traffic Act and the Reduced-Speed School Zones Regulation No. 136/2013.

Establishment of reduced-speed school zones

3. The following portion of highway is designated as a reduced-speed school zone with reduced maximum permitted speed:

- (a) Name of School: Reston School, 516 First Street, Reston

Location of the reduced-speed school zone set out in Schedule "A" attached:

That portion of First Street beginning where the northern limit of First Street meets PTH No. 2 and ending at a point 89 meters south of the north side of Third Avenue.

That portion of Fourth Avenue from First Street to a point 35 meters west of the west boundary Fourth Street and Fourth Avenue.

Maximum permitted speed within reduced-speed school zones

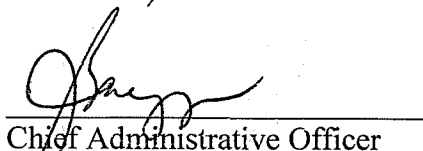
4. The maximum permitted speed for vehicles being driven in a reduced-speed school zone on a highway is 30 km/h.

Times when reduced-speed school zones apply

5. The reduced maximum permitted speeds established under section 4 apply at all times within a reduced-speed school zone.
6. The Municipality shall identify the reduced-speed school zone with traffic control devices that comply with the Reduced-Speed School Zones Regulation No. 136/13.
