

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF KAPUSKASING

BY-LAW NO. 4686

Being a by-law to designate community safety zones and school zones on highways under their jurisdiction and to establish a reduced speed limit of 40 km/hr on designated highways and roadways within the Municipality and to repeal by-law 2772 as amended.

WHEREAS sections 128 and 214.1 of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. H.8, as amended, authorize municipalities to regulate speed limits and designate Community Safety Zones and School Zones on highways under their jurisdiction;

WHEREAS it is desirable that reduced rates of speed be established for motor vehicles driven on highways in school zones;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF KAPUSKASING ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. DEFINITIONS

Community Safety Zone means a designated area where increased penalties apply for certain offences under the Highway Traffic Act.

School Zone means a designated area adjacent to, or in close proximity to, a school property intended to enhance the safety of school children.

Highway has the same meaning as defined in the Highway Traffic Act.

Municipality means the Corporation of the Town of Kapuskasing.

2. DESIGNATION OF COMMUNITY SAFETY ZONES

2.1 The highways or portions of highways identified in Schedule "A" are hereby designated as Community Safety Zones.

2.2 Community Safety Zones shall be in effect at all times.

3. DESIGNATION OF SCHOOL ZONE

3.1 The highways or portions of highways identified in Schedule "B" are hereby designated as School Zones.

3.2 School Zones shall be in effect on days when school is regularly held, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. or as otherwise indicated by authorized signage erected in accordance with the Highway Traffic Act.

4. REDUCED SPEED LIMIT – 40 KM/HR

4.1 No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a rate of speed greater than forty (40) kilometres per hour on any highway or portion thereof designated as a Community Safety Zone or School Zone under this By-law.

4.2 The reduced speed limit shall apply only where authorized regulatory signage has been erected in accordance with the Highway Traffic Act.

5. SIGNAGE

5.1 The Municipality shall erect and maintain signage indicating the

commencement and termination of each Community Safety Zone and School Zone, in accordance with the Highway Traffic Act and its regulations.

6. ENFORCEMENT

6.1 This By-law shall be enforced by the Ontario Provincial Police and any other officers authorized under the Highway Traffic Act.

7. EFFECTIVE DATE

7.1 This By-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of its passing.

COMMUNITY SAFETY ZONE (IN EFFECT AT ALL TIMES)

- (a) All Designated School Zones as per Schedule "B" to By-Law No. 4686 are Designated Community Safety Zones.
- (b) Riverside Drive from Kiddies Korner Daycare (100 Riverside Drive) to a point 150 meters westerly and to Drury Street.
- (c) Mundy Avenue from Riverside Drive to Drury Street
- (d) Bowman Avenue from Riverside Drive to Drury Street
- (e) Seaborne Crescent from Clark Street to Kennedy Avenue
- (f) Kimberly Drive from Clark Street to Kennedy Avenue
- (g) Bowman Avenue from Egerton Street to Devonshire Street
- (h) Dominion Avenue from Montgomery Avenue to Devonshire Street
- (i) McPherson Avenue from Government Road to Riverside Drive
- (j) Riverside Drive from McPherson Avenue to King Street
- (k) Montcalm Avenue from de L'Étang Boulevard to the end of the road.
- (l) Kolb Avenue from Riverside Drive to Henderson Avenue
- (m) Queen Street from Kolb Avenue to a point 150m north along Queen Street

SCHOOL ZONES (8:00AM TO 5:00PM – MONDAY TO FRIDAY)

- (a) Devonshire Street from Bowman Avenue to Queen Street.
- (b) Montgomery Avenue from Devonshire Street to Park Crescent.
- (c) Park Crescent from Montgomery Avenue to Egerton Street.
- (d) Anderson Avenue from Devonshire Street to Egerton Street.
- (e) Egerton Street from Bowman Avenue to Hall Avenue.
- (f) Murdock Street from Anderson Avenue to Queen Street.
- (g) Avenue Road from Murdock Street to Progress Crescent
- (h) Queen Street from Stewart Avenue to Murdock Street.
- (i) Mundy Avenue from King Street to Cedar Street.
- (j) Hall Avenue from Aurora Avenue to Egerton Street.
- (k) Aurora Avenue from Devonshire Street to Devonshire Street.
- (l) Corona Avenue from King Street to Aurora Avenue.
- (m) Summers Avenue from King Street to Aurora Avenue.
- (n) King Street from Bowman Avenue to Mundy Avenue.
- (o) Dominion Avenue from Bowman Avenue to Montgomery Avenue.
- (p) Byng Avenue from Stewart Street to 122 Byng Avenue.
- (q) Cedar Street from Mundy Avenue to the end of Cedar Street.
- (r) Spruce Street from Mundy Avenue to Hemlock Street.
- (s) Pine Crescent from Mundy Avenue to Poplar Crescent.
- (t) Birch Street from Elm Street to Cedar Street.
- (u) Oak Street from Birch Street to Birch Street.
- (v) Balsam Avenue from Cedar Street to Brunetville Road.
- (w) Cherry Avenue from Cedar Street to Brunetville Road.
- (x) Brunelle Road South from Mill Street to Government Road.
- (y) Mill Street from Brunelle Road South to Thibeault Street.
- (z) Government Road from a point 76.2 meters east of Brunelle Road to a point 76.2 meters west of Brunelle Road.
- (aa) Brunelle Road North from Cournoyer Street to Government Road.
- (bb) Lemarier Avenue from a point 60.9 meters west of Brunelle Road South to Brunelle Road South.
- (cc) Bouldier Street from Downs Avenue to Mill Street.
- (dd) Hill Street from Downs Avenue to Mill Street.
- (ee) Cité des Jeunes Boulevard from Brunelle Road North to Brock Crescent.
- (ff) Brock Crescent from Ontario Street to Brunetville Road.
- (gg) Marquette Crescent from Cité des Jeunes Boulevard to Erickson Avenue.
- (hh) Erickson Avenue from Cité des Jeunes Boulevard to Brunetville Road.
