

**TOWN OF BRIDGEWATER POLICY
APPOINTMENT OF CITIZENS TO BOARDS,
COMMITTEES AND COMMISSIONS**

BE IT RESOLVED that the policy of the Town of Bridgewater with respect to citizen appointments to Boards, Committees, and Commissions within the town shall be as follows:

1. Advertise such positions in the local paper at least once per calendar year.
2. Receive, record and circulate applications to those Boards, Committees and Commissions deemed appropriate;
3. Require all Boards, Committees and Commissions under its jurisdiction to recommend appointees for Council's consideration from those qualified applicants who apply;
4. Appoint citizens to as many Boards, Committees and Commissions as deemed appropriate;
5. Appoint for a term of one year with a maximum of five consecutive one year appointments with exception to the Boards, Committees and Commissions which, by statute or by-law, already have a longer time established;
6. Applicants names to be kept on file for one calendar year.
